A note about sign-up forms and links

Certain activities have ancillary or proprietary booking forms, for example JH, YFHS & Link Group residential. BYM events, notably online youth group, have central sign-up forms.

Costs & Bursaries

When event has some small cost associated with it, eg. Pizza, our default is "free – donations welcomed". Funding for my role comes from Yorkshire Quakers, so if you are a Yorkshire Quaker with a direct debit I wouldn't worry at all, if not, consider contributing, but know that is totally optional. Some events have more significant costs associated with them, residentials or high ticket activities like climbing or trampolining. These say "chargeable", however bursaries are available in every case.
