- Turning the Tide in East Africa is a social justice, nonviolence, and peacebuilding programme that equips and supports grassroots communities to address underlying causes of violence and injustice.
- Quakers in Britain work in partnership with the “Africa Center for Nonviolence & Sustainable Impact” (AfriNov) in Kenya, Rwanda Yearly Meeting in Rwanda, and the Ministry for Peace and Reconciliation under the Cross (MIPAREC) in Burundi. Our regional partners lead and deliver Turning the Tide in East Africa.

Peace education in schools

- We work with teachers, volunteers, children and partners to nurture peace at different levels
- Nurturing inner peace so that children value themselves; and providing the tools to enable them to become peacemakers.



Peacebuilding in Britain

- We provide participatory accompaniment to support and bolster peacebuilding in Britain, this includes listening conversations, sharing thinking and practice, and supporting networks.
- We are exploring work with faith organisations, groups, and networks (including Quakers), to develop and strengthen responsive, creative, and transformative approaches to peace and conflict in localities where invited.



Conciliation

- Conciliation work is currently being carried out by an appointed group of Friends.
- The group is developing a pool of Friends for possible future conciliation work in other countries, as the work it has been doing for many years has reached fruition.
